Summary

This bulletin is for information purposes only.

In April, AGCO released AG3000, the new solution for automatic guidance. AG3000 replaces System150 Guidance. The primary advantage in combines with this new system is integration in to the C2100 monitor, which means the additional monitor is not required. The AG3000 system was available, factory installed, from Serial Number AGCRS7700DHTV7258 and forward, or May 1, 2013.

- The AG3000 system utilizes the AGI-4 GPS Receiver, this is the smaller, white receiver, often referred to as a TopDoc.
 - The C3000 terminal can be purchased if a separate monitor is desired.
- The System150 utilized the AGI-3 GPS Receiver, which was the larger yellow receiver, or "TopDoc".

The System150 kit can be used in the newer combines, and the AG3000 kit can be used in combines beginning with the addition of the C2100 monitor. Please see the table below for clarification.
